Starnberg is extending the functions for free charging at the city's "Light & Charge" stations.

STARNBERG. With the "Light & Charge" System for electric vehicles, eluminocity GmbH delivers the key to an urban, full-coverage implementation of e-Mobility. Since August 2015, electric car drivers can charge their vehicles in Ludwigstr. 6 in Starnberg for free. From August this year, there will be introduced an authorization process via RFID Card or QR Code to allow users to charge barrier-free in the future. Charging continues to remain free with this roaming possibility. The electric driver can provide authorization by placing a RFID Card to the upper end of the charging station. In case of not possessing any RFID Card, the user of the charging station can alternatively scan the affixed QR Code with his mobile phone to unlock the charging process. The city of Starnberg wants to analyze the charging behavior to optimize the usage and to offer residents in the local community the best possible infrastructure.

eluminocity developed in cooperation with the BMW Group the modular product system "Light & Charge" to transform street lights into charging stations for electric vehicles. The company offers a retrofit of street lights with highly efficient LED lighting combined with integrated EV charging solutions in a fully connected system.
